EXPLANATION OF THE TENDER DOCUMENTATION – III.

The contracting authority of the above-threshold public contract "Boiler B14" for supplies awarded in a negotiated procedure with publication according to Act No. 134/2016 Coll., on Public Procurement, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), hereby explains the tender documentation in accordance with the provisions of § 98 of the Act.

Question no. 1:

Clause 21.1.2 of the RFQ provides as one technical qualification criteria that the Supplier shall have performed maintenance contracts for at least 12 months during the last 10 years. Can you please confirm that such references, which are located outside of the European Union and/or references which uses 100% waste as fuel will meet your qualification criteria and can be used under the said clause of the RFQ?

Answer to question no. 1:

Article 21.1.2. of the tender documentation sets a qualification criterium, which involves a requirement to prove that the supplier provided one significant completed supply over the past ten years before the commencement of the procurement procedure, which involved provision of comprehensive warranty, post-warranty, or out-of-warranty service and maintenance continuously for a period of at least 12 months for the BFB or CFB. The article 21.1.2. further states that the supply must have been provided within the European Union.

The contracting authority therefore clarifies that only supply located within the European Union can be used as reference to meet the above-mentioned qualification criterion. The reason for this requirement is to demonstrate that the supplier can comply with European Union legislation.

The contracting authority further states that references for supplies using 100% waste as fuel are not in conflict with the requirements set out in Article 21.1.2 and can therefore be used. The contracting authority only sets requirements regarding the type of technology used, specifically BFB or CFB combustion technology.

However, the contracting authority points out that the primary purpose of the qualification criterion in Article 21.1.2 is to demonstrate the provision of warranty, post-warranty, or out-of-warranty service and maintenance continuously for a period of at least 12 months.
